ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21567 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 14 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 18 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING SECTION 22.1801(b) RELATING TO CITY
DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the consolidation of the Debt Management Department within the Finance Department and the establishment of the Strategic Capital Projects Department; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 26 requires the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) to adopt an Administrative Code in the San Diego Municipal Code, describing the detailed powers and duties of City administrative offices and departments; and

WHEREAS, the Council approved the consolidation of the Debt Management Department with the Finance Department by San Diego Ordinance O- 21565 passed on NOV 01 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Council approved establishing the Strategic Capital Projects Department by San Diego Ordinance O- 21566 passed on NOV 01 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends updating the list of all City departments in Division 18 of the Administrative Code to delete the Debt Management Department and add the Strategic Capital Projects Department; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 26, the Council must approve, by a two-thirds vote, the establishment of new departments or the consolidation of existing departments in the Administrative Code by ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 18 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

§22.1801 City Departments
