AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH GHD INC. FOR THE OTAY 1ST AND 2ND PIPELINES WEST OF HIGHLAND AVENUE PROJECT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Otay 1st and 2nd pipelines (Pipelines) were originally built in 1915 and 1930, respectively, and used to supply raw water from the Lower Otay Reservoir to the old University Heights Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, in 1950, the Pipelines were decommissioned and converted to distribute potable water; and

WHEREAS, in 2000, a corrosion assessment identified several areas of concern in the Pipelines; and

WHEREAS, the Pipelines have reached the end of their useful life and now are part of the City of San Diego's Water Main Replacement Program as mandated by California Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2015, the City of San Diego (City) entered into an agreement with GHD Inc. (GHD) in the amount of \$2,120,000.00 (Agreement) for engineering design services and engineering construction support on the Otay 1st and 2nd Pipelines – West of Highland Avenue project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of replacing approximately 5 miles of aged steel, cast iron, and asbestos pipes for the Pipelines; and

WHEREAS, the design for the Project has been completed, and the construction phase of the Project started on December 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the project has encountered several impacts that have caused overall schedule delays including but not limited to, the need to re-advertise the construction contract and water main shutdown restrictions related to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the original term of the agreement was six years and was phase-funded over four fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) approved San Diego Ordinance O-21331 (June 28, 2021), authorizing the execution of a first amendment to the Agreement, extending the Agreement through December 31, 2022 (First Amendment); and

WHEREAS, in order for GHD to continue to provide uninterrupted engineering services throughout the entire construction phase and the project close-out phase, a second amendment to the Agreement is necessary to further extend the term of the Agreement (Second Amendment); and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment will extend the Agreement for another year, through December 31, 2023, in order for GHD to continue to provide essential engineering support services as part of the original scope of work; and

WHEREAS, all four funding phases have been appropriated, and there is existing budget available to cover the Second Amendment's time extension through the end of construction and project close-out phases; and

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WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation

extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved

by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the

information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute the Second

Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement for another year through

December 31, 2023.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
