AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 6 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 141.0619 RELATING TO PUSHCARTS AND SIDEWALK VENDORS.

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the San Diego City Council approved two ordinances—one to regulate sidewalk vending throughout the City of San Diego (Sidewalk Vending Ordinance) and the other to repeal provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) that regulated pushcarts in the public right-of-way (Pushcart Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, the Pushcart Ordinance is subject to California Coastal Commission (Coastal Commission) approval as an amendment to the Local Coastal Program; and

WHEREAS, Coastal Commission staff has requested that the City amend the Pushcart Ordinance to include a reference to sidewalk vendors to ensure public access to the shoreline; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 14, Article 1, Division 6 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 141.0619, to read as follows:

§141.0619 Pushcarts on Private Property and Sidewalk Vendors

This Section regulates pushcarts on private property and Sidewalk Vendors.

Pushcarts are moveable, wheeled, non-motorized vehicles used by vendors for the sale of food or beverage products, fresh-cut flowers, or live plants in pots.

Pushcarts are a health-regulated business subject to Section 42.0102. For purposes of this section, Sidewalk Vendor has the same meaning as in San Diego

Municipal Code Section 36.0102.

(a) Pushcarts on Private Property

Pushcarts are permitted on private property as a limited use in the zones indicated with an "L" in the Use Regulations Tables in Chapter 13,

Article 1 (Base Zones) subject to the following regulations.

- (1) Pushcarts are not permitted in required *yards*, required landscape areas, or required parking areas.
- (2) Pushcarts shall not exceed 4 feet in width, not including wheels; 8 feet in length, including handles; and 6 feet in height, not including canopies, umbrellas, and transparent enclosures.
- (3) Pushcart operators shall not verbally solicit business from pedestrians or persons in vehicles and shall not sell to persons in vehicles.
- (4) The price of items sold shall be posted on the pushcart and shall be clearly legible.

(b) Sidewalk Vendors

Sidewalk Vendors shall not interfere with public access to the shoreline, as identified in *land use plans* that are part of the certified *Local Coastal Program*.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage, except that the provisions of this ordinance applicable inside the

Coastal Overlay Zone, which are subject to Coastal Commission jurisdiction as a City

of San Diego Local Coastal Program amendment, shall not take effect until the date the Coastal

Commission unconditionally certifies those provisions as a local coastal program amendment.

Section 4. That San Diego Ordinances O-2022-1 (Transit Priority Area Non-Residential

Parking); Ordinance O-2022-17 (Airport Amendments); O-2022-34 (Spaces as Places);

O-2022 36, O-2022-37, and O-2022-48 (Barrio Logan Community Plan Update); and O-2022-59

and O-2022-60 (2021 Municipal Code Update) have been recently considered by the City

Council, all of which amend Municipal Code sections also amended by this ordinance; therefore,

the City Clerk, with the written approval and concurrence of the City Attorney, is authorized to

reconcile the numbering of sections and placement of text within these sections upon the final

passage of the ordinances, without further action by the City Council, pursuant to San Diego

Charter section 275.
