A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (HSIP) FOR THE TORREY PINES ROAD (PROSPECT STREET TO COAST WALK) PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST) was signed into law on December 4, 2015. Under FAST, the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), codified as section 148 of Title 23, United States Code (23 U.S.C. § 148), is a core federal-aid program to States for the purpose of achieving a significant reduction in fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Assistance (DLA) manages California's local agency share of HSIP funds. California's Local HSIP focuses on infrastructure projects with nationally recognized crash reduction factors (CRFs). Local HSIP projects must be identified on the basis of crash experience, crash potential, crash rate, or other data-supported means; and

WHEREAS, the Torrey Pines Road (Prospect Street to Coast Walk) Guardrail project provides for a permanent solution for the protection of motorists and pedestrians along the north side of Torrey Pines Rd. (Project); and

WHEREAS, Torrey Pines Road carries over 60,000 vehicles per day and is frequently covered in a marine layer of dense fog, making visibility of the curve particularly challenging. A safety rail will prevent out-of-control vehicles from falling over the embankment into surrounding homes, hitting fixed objects, and striking pedestrians walking along the sidewalk, greatly reducing the risk of fatal and severe crashes at this location; and

WHEREAS, interim improvements including chain-link fences, signing and striping

modifications narrowing the travel way, and a temporary K-rail concrete barrier have been

installed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to

secure HSIP Cycle 10 grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$718,700 in grant funding for

CIP AIE00002, Guard Rails (B-19056, Torrey Pines Rd, Prospect-Coast Walk GR), to support

the design and construction phases.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend

HSIP Cycle 10 grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$718,700 contingent upon receipt of a

fully executed grant agreement.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-

bearing account for the grant, if required.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital

Improvement Program Budget in CIP AIE00002, Guard Rails (B-19056, Torrey Pines Rd.

Prospect-Coast Walk GR), and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$718,700

within Fund 600001, Grant Fund State.
