

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 313881DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 23 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF A 50-YEAR GROUND LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND ALEXANDER COURT TRUST FOR APPROXIMATELY 2.98 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2150 PACIFIC BEACH DRIVE FOR THE CEDAR SHORES APARTMENT PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) proposes to enter into that certain Percentage Ground Lease with Alexander Court Trust (Lessee) to allow Lessee's renovation (including interior and exterior upgrades) of an existing 120-unit residential development, commonly known as Cedar Shores Apartments, located at 2150 Pacific Beach Drive, San Diego, California, as well as Lessee's continued operation of the residential units for a period of 50 years (collectively, Project); and

WHEREAS, within the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000, *et seq.*), Public Resources Code section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, *et seq.*) adopted by the California Office of Planning and Research under Public Resources Code section 21083 shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 through 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines section 15301 provides a categorical exemption from CEQA for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Department determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record and related public comment with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that the Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15301; and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that no exception set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project because no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; none of the land is adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources will be affected by the action; and none of the land is identified on a list of hazardous waste sites under California Government Code section 65962.5; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

2. No exception to the categorical exemption, set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project.
