A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE SB 1383 LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the State; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill (SB) 1383 (Lara, Chapter 395, Statutes of 2016), enacted in 2016, establishes methane emission reduction targets and requires California to reduce organic waste disposal in landfills by 75 percent by 2025 and increase edible food recovery by 20 percent by 2025; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle is administering a grant program to provide aid in the implementation of regulations adopted by CalRecycle pursuant to Chapter 395, Statutes of 2016 and SB 170 Budget Act of 2021 (Grant Program); and

WHEREAS, the Grant Program provides funding to local jurisdictions to assist with the implementation of regulation requirements associated with SB 1383; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle has established procedures governing the administration of the Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Grant Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Grant Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to submit applications for the SB 1383

Local Assistance Grant Program to CalRecycle on behalf of the City of San Diego for Fiscal

Year 2022 through and including Fiscal Year 2026.

2. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized and empowered to negotiate and

execute, for and on behalf of the City, all Grant Program-related documents, including

applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary to secure Grant Program

funding, implement and close out the Grant Program, and administer the City's obligations,

responsibilities, and duties under the terms and conditions of the Grant Program for Fiscal Year

2022 through and including Fiscal Year 2026.

3. That, for the purposes of this Grant Program, the Mayor's designee includes the

Environmental Services Department Director and Deputy Director.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend

funds from the Grant Program for the purposes of the Grant Program, contingent upon securing

funding and execution of Grant Program agreements.
