A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$9,500 TO THE TRANS CAN WORK, INC., FOR MATCHING FUNDING FOR THE WORKFORCE ACCELERATOR FUND 9.0 IN SAN DIEGO, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Trans Can Work has requested funding for the Workforce Accelerator Fund 9.0 in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to support a fulltime employment navigator and fulltime management in San Diego, and to employ part-time licensed social worker at the Owen Clinic for case management to assist clients with other needs; and

WHEREAS, Trans Can Work's request for funding for the Workforce Accelerator Fund 9.0 in San Diego will benefit the public by eliminating barriers to employment for the one of the most marginalized communities; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 2, 3, and 7 recommend a total allocation of \$9,500 to Trans Can Work for the purposes set forth in this resolution, attributed as follows: Council District 2 – \$3,000; Council District 3 – \$5,000; and Council District 7 – \$1,500; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2022 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and Trans Can Work (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$9,500 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313926.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1102110002; \$5,000 from Council District 3: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000,

G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1103110003; and \$1,500 from Council District 7: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1107110007, for a total of \$9,500, all to provide funds for the abovereferenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
