A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH NV5 INC. FOR AS-NEEDED PLAN CHECK AND INSPECTION SERVICES IN THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$250,000.

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department (DSD) has experienced increased workload volume for all permit types, including discretionary entitlements and ministerial building and right-of-way permits, and must augment its workforce in order to reduce the backlog of projects to be processed as DSD works to fill departmental vacancies; and

WHEREAS, in addition to increased work volume, pandemic related staff turnover and nationwide labor shortages have extended the time DSD takes to accept, review, and issue a permit; and

WHEREAS, DSD desires to utilize an as-needed contract to temporarily augment and support existing DSD personnel with processing and reviewing permits to clear the permit backlog while vacant positions continue to be filled and trained; and

WHEREAS, through a comprehensive selection process via use of the City's Consultant Rotation List, NV5 Inc., was selected to provide as-needed plan check and inspection services to DSD for an amount not to exceed \$250,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute an agreement with NV5 Inc. for as-needed plan check and inspection services for the Development Services Department in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,000 from FY 2022 Enterprise Fund (700036), Development Services Department, for the minimum obligation for services required under the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend a total amount not to exceed \$250,000 from FY 2022 Enterprise Fund (700036), Development Services Department, for the as-needed services allowed under the Agreement.
