A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FISCAL YEAR 2023 PARK AND RECREATION CENTER FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department (Department) has established 60 Recreation Center Funds, one for each of the 59 recreation centers and one for Therapeutic Recreation Services; and

WHEREAS, the Department has developed proposed budgets for those Recreation

Center Funds taking the recommendations and requests of the community into consideration; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2022 the Council of the City of San Diego, through Resolution R-313898, approved the addition of a new Opportunity Fund fee that will apply to permitted events, facilities used by sports leagues, room and pool rentals, and on-going recreation-based business operations by commercial and non-profit entities, which fall within one of the exceptions to Prop 26. The fee is in addition to applicable park use and facility rental fees. Collection of fees for the Opportunity Fund will start after July 1, 2022 and Recreation Center Funds that serve communities of concern will have funding added from these fees; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend Recreation Center Funds in Fiscal Year 2023 as detailed in Attachment A: Proposed Fiscal Year 2023 Recreation Center Funds Budgets attached to the Staff Report, where column B and column D are the revenue and expense amounts that will be appropriated, respectively.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the estimated Fiscal Year 2022 Carry Forward funds

will be available to appropriate during Fiscal Year 2023 and are subject to change upon completion of the City's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend Recreation Center Funds, generated from permit fees, outside the geographic area in which the funds were collected to promote Parks and Recreation Department-wide recreation programs.
