A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATIFYING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S APPROVAL OF A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE DEVELOPER OF THE 13TH & BROADWAY AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT, OR ITS DEVELOPMENT DESIGNEE, FOR A LOAN AND A GRANT FROM THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$20 MILLION, AND APPROVING THE SUBSTITUTION OF CHELSEA INVESTMENT CORPORATION AS PROJECT SPONSOR.

WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program, established under Division 44, Part 1 of the Public Resources Code section 75200 et seq., funds certain types of project areas by providing grants and/or loans that will achieve greenhouse gas emissions reductions and benefit disadvantaged communities by increasing accessibility of affordable housing and sustainable transportation; and

WHEREAS the AHSC Program is administered by the Strategic Growth Council (SGC) and implemented by the California Department of Housing and Community Development (Department); and

WHEREAS, the State of California, SGC, and the Department issued a Notice of Funding Availability under the AHSC Program dated November 1, 2018 (NOFA), with an application deadline of February 11, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2019, the City entered into a Disposition and Development Agreement with Chelsea Investment Corporation, a California corporation (Developer), to develop an affordable housing project located at 1320 Broadway, San Diego, 92101, and commonly known as 13th and Broadway in the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area (Project); and

WHEREAS, City Council approved a Joint Application with Developer, or its development designee, to apply for \$20 million in AHSC Program funds under Resolution R-312207; and

WHEREAS, Developer identified SVDP Management, Inc. (SVDP) as the project sponsor and managing general partner in the joint application with City; and

WHEREAS, Developer, or development designee, was awarded \$20 million in AHSC Program funds, with Developer receiving \$13.7 million as a loan for the Project (AHSC Loan), and the City receiving as a grant \$6.3 million for Housing-Related Infrastructure, Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI), Transit-Related Amenities (TRA), or Program (PGM) activities (collectively, AHSC Grant) that is anticipated to be used for construction of the Downtown Mobility Plan improvements and transportation-related programs; and

WHEREAS, Developer will serve as project sponsor and joint applicant, and shall designate Alpha Project for the Homeless, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (Alpha) to serve as project co-sponsor; and

WHEREAS, Developer will serve as project sponsor and joint applicant; and
WHEREAS, the Department has been informed and conditionally approved of the
proposed change, and requests that City prepare and approved an updated resolution reflecting
these changes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council finds and determines that all recitals set forth in this Resolution are true and correct and fully incorporated in this Resolution.
- 2. The City Council ratifies its prior action approving a joint application with Developer of the 13th and Broadway Housing Project to the AHSC program.

funds from the Department.
