A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH
POLYDYNE INC. (BID NO. 10089845-22-J) TO PURCHASE
ANIONIC POLYMER FOR POINT LOMA, PUBLIC UTILITIES
DEPARTMENT; AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department (PUD) utilizes approximately 80,000 dry pounds of Anionic polymer each year as part of the wastewater treatment process at the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant (PLWWTP) to separate the incoming solids from liquids through a process called flocculation in sedimentation basins; and

WHEREAS, the City's prior contract for Anionic polymer expired on October 12, 2021, and the Public Utilities Department (PUD) requested authorization for an emergency purchase of Anionic polymer for this critical health and safety function; and

WHEREAS, in January and May 2022, the Purchasing and Contracting Department approved a request by the Public Utilities Department to create purchase orders in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for Anionic polymer chemical purchases in order to continue critical wastewater treatment with the existing vendor, Polydyne Inc., while this Council Action Request routed for approval; and

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid (ITB), 10089845-22-J, for the purchase of Anionic polymer was released by Purchasing & Contracting Department on February 11, 2022, and the Purchasing & Contracting Department determined Polydyne Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and sent a Notice of Intent to Award on April 7, 2022 (Contract); and

WHEREAS, the PUD purchase order expenses for Anionic polymer chemical purchases in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 are included in this Council Action Request to approve

authorization of the emergency Anionic polymer purchase order expenditures, and for future Anionic polymer in a total amount not to exceed \$5,123,180; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a one (1) year contract with four (4) additional one-year options with Polydyne Inc. to provide Anionic Polymer as required, in an amount not to exceed \$5,123,180, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-314204, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$5,123,180, of which \$400,000 is estimated to be spent in FY 2022 from Fund 700001, Metro Sewer Utility Fund, and an estimated \$4,723,180 for all subsequent years from Fund 700001, Metro Sewer Utility Fund for the purpose of funding the Anionic Polymer contract with Polydyne Inc., contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
