DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 25 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE A BALLOT TITLE AND SUMMARY AND AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS; DIRECTING THE MAYOR, INDEPENDENT BUDGET ANALYST AND CITY AUDITOR TO PREPARE A FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS; AND ASSIGNING BALLOT ARGUMENTS; ALL REGARDING A MEASURE RELATING TO COASTAL ZONE HEIGHT LIMITS IN THE MIDWAY-PACIFIC HIGHWAY COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AT THE MUNICIPAL SPECIAL ELECTION, CONSOLIDATED WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE GENERAL ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0504 allows the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) to direct the City Attorney to prepare a ballot title and summary of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) section 27.0505 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 27.0506 directs the Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or the Mayor's designee) and the City Auditor, to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of a proposed legislative act; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 27.0513 allows the City Council to assign to itself, individual Councilmembers, and the Mayor, the authorship and signing of a ballot argument in support of, or in opposition to, a ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on July 25, 2022, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O- 21508, to place on the November 8, 2022 Municipal Special Election ballot, one measure, submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego, for their approval or rejection, that would amend Municipal Code section 132.0505 (People's Ordinance 10960) and relates to coastal zone height limits in the Midway-Pacific Highway Community Plan Area; and

WHEREAS, the measure was proposed by Councilmember Chris Cate through the Council Policy 000-21 process, heard by the City Council's Rules Committee on April 20, 2022, and June 8, 2022; and by the City Council on July 25, 2022; and the City Council adopted the ordinance, placing the measure on the ballot

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Charter section 295(d), this resolution relating to matters to submit to City voters at a Municipal Special Election is not subject to veto by the Mayor, and thus the date of its passage by the City Council shall be deemed the date of final passage; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Attorney is directed to prepare a ballot title and summary, and an impartial analysis, of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the ballot title and summary, and the impartial analysis, to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 16, 2022.

2. The Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or the Mayor's designee) and the City Auditor, is directed to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the analysis to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 16, 2022.

3. Councilmember Chris Cate is authorized to sign and file a written ballot argument in favor of the ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet, and to deliver the argument to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 19, 2022.
