DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE SEP 21 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE AS-NEEDED AGREEMENT  
WITH SOUTHWEST PIPELINE & TRENCHLESS  
CORPORATION FOR CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE (CIPP) LINING  
AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) Wastewater Collection Division (WWD) operates and maintains approximately 3,000 miles of sewer pipelines and the City must repair and rehabilitate pipelines to extend the service life of these critical wastewater assets; and

WHEREAS, during WWD routine preventive maintenance and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) inspections, pipes are identified for repairs, rehabilitation (lining) and replacement; and

WHEREAS, trenchless reconstruction is an innovative method of rehabilitating pipes with minimal impacts to communities by repairing the sewer pipelines using a resin saturated insert into the existing deteriorated pipe which cures the resin and forms a new pipe within the existing pipe; and

WHEREAS, the use of trenchless technology eliminates the need for open trench excavation to repair or rehabilitate the deteriorating pipelines, thus extending their lifespan and mitigating potential sanitary sewer spills due to failed or collapsed sewer pipe. Trenchless reconstruction services expedite sewer pipe repairs, improve structural integrity of the repaired pipes, lower maintenance costs, extend the service life, minimize community impacts, and prevent sewer spills; and

WHEREAS, approximately 10,160 feet of pipes, ranging from two to 24 inches in diameter will be repaired under this As-Needed Agreement, with 1,400 feet to be repaired during

FY 2023 and approximately 2,200 feet during each subsequent year of this five-year As-Needed Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2021, the Public Utilities Department (PUD), WWD, issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the As-Needed CIPP Lining and advertised it on the City's Electronic Proposal website, PlanetBids, and on May 10, 2022, Purchasing and Contracting issued an Award Recommendation Memo for Southwest Pipeline and Trenchless Corporation and issued a Notice of Intent to Award on May 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute the five-year As-Needed Agreement with Southwest Pipeline & Trenchless Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$3,791,250 for trenchless reconstruction services of the existing sewer gravity mains and service laterals, under the terms and conditions set forth in the As-Needed Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Doc. No. RR-314319.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,791,250 from Fund 700000 Muni Sewer Revenue, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for

expenditure under the established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the  
City Treasurer.


