A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT RATIFICATION OF THE AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSESS IN THE BUSINESS, CONSUMER SERVICES AND HOUSING AGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF ROUND 1 OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA FAMILY HOMELESSNESS CHALLENGE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize acceptance, appropriation, and expenditure of Round 1 of the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant Program (FHC-1) funds in an amount not to exceed \$441,151.13 and ratify execution of the agreement for the FHC-1 grant with the California Interagency Council on Homelessness in the Business,

Consumer Services and Housing Agency, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-: 314351 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically

exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (Existing Facilities), and that

no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written

record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing

Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or

minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no

expansion of existing or former use; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301, and that an

exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
