A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO RATIFYING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE  
CALIFORNIA INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON  
HOMELESSNESS IN THE BUSINESS, CONSUMER  
SERVICES AND HOUSING AGENCY AND AUTHORIZING  
THE ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE  
OF ROUND 1 OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA FAMILY  
HOMELESSNESS CHALLENGE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the State of California has established the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant Program (Program), which is administered by the California Interagency Council on Homelessness (Cal ICH) in the Business, Consumer Services, and Housing Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Program provides grants and technical assistance in two rounds of funding to fund innovative projects that accelerate efforts by local jurisdictions and continuums of care to address and end family homelessness by making families' experiences of homelessness rare, brief, and one-time; and

WHEREAS, Jewish Family Service (JFS) operates the City of San Diego's Safe Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, the Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department (HSSD) collaborated with JFS on the grant application for the Program which focused on serving families living in their vehicles by offering the following assistance, with the goal being to connect families living in their vehicles to stable housing: (1) prevention and shelter diversion; (2) rapid rehousing and housing services through security deposits and rental subsidies; (3) interim sheltering; and (4) cash assistance for basic needs such as food and gas; and

WHEREAS, after approval from the City's Grant Review Team, HSSD staff submitted the grant application for round 1 of the Program (FHC-1) at the end of April 2022; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2022, the City received the award letter from Cal ICH for FHC-1 in an amount not to exceed of \$441,151.13; and

WHEREAS, in July 21, 2022, HSSD staff received the contract for review from Cal ICH, with a deadline to submit the signed contract no later than August 20, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City signed and submitted the contract to Cal ICH by the deadline to not miss the grant opportunity and is now requesting the Council of the City of San Diego ratify the grant agreement and authorize the acceptance, appropriation, and expenditure of the awarded FHC-1 funds; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend Round 1 of the Family Homelessness Challenge Grant Program (FHC-1) funds in an amount not to exceed \$441,151.13.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor's, or designee's, signature on the agreement with the California Interagency Council on Homelessness in the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency for the FHC-1 grant, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **314351**, is ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor, manage, and ensure compliance with the FHC-1 grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the FHC-1 grant, if required, the proceeds of which will be used for any eligible uses outlined in the FHC-1 grant materials.
