A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING PROPOSITION 1, RIGHT TO REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM AMENDMENT, ON THE NOVEMBER 2022 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2022, State Senate President Pro Tempore Toni Atkins introduced Senate Constitutional Amendment 10 (SCA-10) "Reproductive Freedom" to amend the California Constitution to prohibit the State from denying or interfering with an individual's reproductive freedom, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2022, the United States Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*, which had been in effect for nearly 50 years, guaranteeing the constitutional right to abortion; and

WHEREAS, even before the Supreme Court decision regarding *Roe v. Wade* was issued, the City of San Diego was engaged with reproductive justice advocates, working to uphold everyone's equality and liberty by protecting patients seeking abortion access and reproductive freedom; and

WHEREAS, SCA-10 passed both the California Senate and Assembly and is moving forward to the statewide general ballot in November as Proposition 1; and

WHEREAS, if Proposition 1 is approved by California voters, the constitutional amendment will codify the right to abortion and contraceptives in the State; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego supports Proposition 1, the California Constitutional amendment establishing the right to abortion and contraception in the State of California, on the November 2022 ballot.
