A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC POWER FEASIBILITY STUDY CONSULTANT CONTRACT AWARD TO NEWGEN STRATEGIES & SOLUTIONS LLC IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, concurrent and together with this resolution the City is determining to award a contract (Contract) for the performance of a Public Power Feasibility Study to NewGen Strategies and Solutions LLC; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Contract is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, on OCT 0 3 2022 , the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Contract as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Contract will not have a significant effect on the environment because it

involves only feasibility or planning studies for possible future actions which the agency, board,

or commission has not approved, adopted or funded; and

information provided by City staff [including information provided by affected third parties and

verified by City staff], with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and

accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines section 15262.
