A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE ORIGINAL SOLE SOURCE AGREEMENT (H166798) WITH MOFFATT & NICHOL FOR ADDITIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES DURING THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE OCEAN BEACH PIER REPLACEMENT PROJECT IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the Ocean Beach Pier, which opened in July 1966, has exceeded its useful life after 56 years of exposure to the harsh marine environment, wind, waves, and salt-laden air. A full replacement of the Pier is necessary to extend the useful life of the asset for future generations; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental

Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), has determined

that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those

classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the

environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, on ______, 2022, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the work performed by Moffat & Nichol meets the requirements of CEQA Guidelines section 15262, in that it is a project involving only feasibility or planning study for possible future actions (i.e. the Ocean Beach Pier replacement) which the City has not approved, adopted, or funded; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262.

2. The City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
