A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE MOBILITY BOARD.

WHEREAS, modes of transportation in the City of San Diego (City) have evolved dramatically in the past decade, with critical issues emerging within the City's transportation network and a need to better coordinate different transportation decisions; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.38 and 26.39, the City created the Mobility Board to advise the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) on the City's transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility Board analyzes transportation decision-making in a holistic way to help the City ensure that people driving, walking, bicycling, taking transit, parking, or using other transportation modes will have safe, easy-to-use choices to move around the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility Board helps ensure the development of the City's transportation network meets the City's Climate Action Plan goals; and

WHEREAS, the Mobility Board is composed of 13 appointed volunteer members serving two-year staggered terms, and members will serve until a new member is duly appointed and confirmed; and

WHEREAS, members of the Mobility Board shall possess expertise in one or more of the following areas: transportation and transit planning, bicycle and pedestrian safety, city planning, parking management, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), construction management, environmental sustainability, and public health; and

WHEREAS, one of the 13 members must have expertise in or demonstrated knowledge of the ADA and accommodation issues; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor now seeks to appoint a member of the Mobility Board, subject to City Council confirmation; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointment by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as a member of the Mobility Board, for the term ending as indicated, is made and hereby confirmed:
