## DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 2.8 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE 7720 KENAMAR COURT REZONE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO SECTION 15301 (EXISTING FACILITIES) OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES - PROJECT NO. 1054295.

WHEREAS, 7720 KENAMAR CT HOLDINGS, LLC, requested a rezone of a 2.8-acre site from the IL-2-1 Zone (Industrial Light Zone) to the IL-3-1 Zone (Industrial Light Zone) located at 7720 Kenamar Court, in the Mira Mesa Community Plan area to expand the gross floor area for an Eating and Drinking Establishment as an allowable use; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 *et seq.*), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2022, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, a project is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) if it consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and

WHEREAS, the Project meets the criteria set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) because it would not result in any substantial changes to the Project site and would not expand an existing or former use; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

 The City Council has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and that an exception to the exemption does not apply.

2. The City Council has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

The City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with 3. the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
