A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO TERMINATING TEMPORARY RULES OF
COUNCIL RELATING TO TIME, PLACE, AND
PROCEDURES FOR COUNCIL MEETINGS IN RESPONSE TO
THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY AND TEMPORARY RULES OF
COUNCIL RELATING TO THE TITLE AND
RESPONSIBILITIES OF COMMITTEE CONSULTANTS AND
COMMITTEE CONSULTANT'S ASSISTANTS.

WHEREAS, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Council (Rules of Council), codified in Chapter 2,
Article 2, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code), provides that the
Council President may, at any time, place on the Adoption Agenda a resolution establishing a
temporary rule that, for the time being, has the effect of a standing rule; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9 further provides that if the temporary rule conflicts with an existing
rule, it shall supersede the permanent rule for such time as may be specified in the temporary
rule; and

WHEREAS, since April 7, 2020, the San Diego City Council (Council) has operated
under temporary Rules of Council relating to the time, place, and procedures for Council
meetings in response to the state of emergency declared by the Governor of California as a result
of the threat of the novel coronavirus, Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution R-314029 (Apr. 5, 2022), the Council adopted
temporary Rules of Council superseding Rules 2.2, 2.7, and 2.10 to address Council procedures
in response to the Covid-19 emergency, which remain in effect until terminated by the Council;
and

WHEREAS, Governor Gavin Newsom recently announced his intent to end the state of emergency related to Covid-19 removing the necessity for some of the temporary Rules of Council adopted in Resolution R-314029; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution R-314208 (Jun. 28, 2022), the Council adopted temporary Rules of Council superseding Rules 6.5.3, 6.6.2, 6.7.3, and 6.9.4 relating to the title and responsibilities of consultants to the Council's standing and special committees; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2022, Council introduced an ordinance amending the permanent Rules of Council (Ordinance) and included amendments addressing processes during virtual meetings and changes to the title and responsibilities of committee consultants that are currently in the temporary Rules of Council adopted by Resolutions R-314029 and R-314208; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance will become effective on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage and Council desires to terminate the temporary Rules of Council adopted by Resolutions R-314029 and R-314208 when the Ordinance goes into effect; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(1), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter is exclusively within the purview of the Council and not affecting the administrative service of the City under the control of the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the temporary Rules of Council adopted by Resolution R-314029 (Apr. 5, 2022) and by Resolution R-314208 (Jun. 28, 2022) will terminate and shall have no further force and effect upon the effective date

of Ordinance O- 21576, which amends the permanent Rules of Council in Chapter 2,
Article 2, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to insert the appropriate
ordinance number above associated with Ordinance O-2022-83, introduced on November 14,
2022, amending the permanent Rules of Council, upon its final passage.
