## DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 1 3 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REPEALING ORDINANCE O-21178, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ACCEPTANCE OF ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES IN PLACE OF ORIGINALS ON ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS DURING THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopted San Diego Ordinance O-21178 (Apr. 7, 2020), in reliance on the COVID-19 emergency declarations by state and local government officials, which authorized the acceptance of electronic signatures in place of original signatures to satisfy legal requirements for signing ordinances and resolutions of the City of San Diego and the City's redevelopment successor agency, without violating state "stay at home" orders and social distancing procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Council now wishes to repeal Ordinance O-21178 because stay at home orders and distancing requirements from the state have been lifted, Governor Newsom is expected to end the state of emergency related to COVID-19 on February 29, 2023, and the City no longer faces operational barriers to return to the legally required process of original signatures on resolutions and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows: Section 1. That Ordinance O-21178 is hereby repealed. Section 2. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day Section 3. from and after its final passage.
