AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE OBLIGATIONS OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT K-18-1472-DBB-3 WITH FLATIRON WEST INC., TO EXTEND BEYOND FIVE YEARS FOR AN ADDITIONAL 14 MONTHS, NOT TO LAST BEYOND JUNE 30, 2024.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2018, the City of San Diego entered into contract

K-18-1472-DBB-3 (Contract) with Flatiron West Inc. (Contractor) to construct the West Mission

Bay Drive Bridge over the San Diego River in an amount not to exceed \$110,742,985; and

WHEREAS, although the remaining construction activities are projected to be completed by March 2023, it is anticipated that it may take an additional 14 months to fully complete the obligations under the Contract, including project close-out items that may need to be addressed by the Contractor and any unforeseen delays that might extend the work beyond April 11, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this action will not add any additional funding or working days beyond what is authorized in the Contract and approved change orders; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to extend the obligations of the Contract beyond the five-year mark to June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the

information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and

verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and

accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the obligations of the Contract to

extend beyond five years to June 30, 2024.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
