ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21603 (NEW SERIES) DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 1 3 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITIONS IN THE RISK MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Risk Management Department (Department) to exempt two Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the first Program Coordinator position will oversee administrative and finance functions for the Department. This position will ensure that reserve funding for the Public Liability, Workers' Compensation, and Long-Term Disability funds complies with the City's Reserve Policy; oversee the Department's components of the City's Annual Comprehensive Financial Statement; establish methods and systems to track Department revenue, expenditures, and purchasing actions; update and review Citywide fringe rates; develop, implement, and monitor internal controls over financial reporting; and recommend and implement modifications to Department standards, policies, and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the second Program Coordinator position will assist a Program Manager position with the administration of application systems and lead project initiatives to deliver services to support the City's claims management system. This position will oversee the replacement of application software; serve to expand system accessibility and functionality to additional City departments and outside agencies; align system requirements with the City's Technical Strategic Plan, mandatory information technology requirements, and best business practices; develop policies and/or recommendations when multiple options are available to meet the legal, technical, and best business practice requirements; make recommendations to change

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City department processes and procedures; and recommend new policies to improve Department operations that have a Citywide impact; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated November 4, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-______; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the two Program Coordinator positions in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-25603.

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Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
