

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21610 (NEW SERIES)DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 30 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PROGRAM MANAGER  
POSITION IN THE SAN DIEGO CITY EMPLOYEES'  
RETIREMENT SYSTEM FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System (Department) to exempt a Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will oversee the Department's information technology programs. This position will oversee and manage the Department's voice and data network, enterprise architecture, and information technology operational activities; oversee security and strategy to prevent, eliminate, and mitigate security vulnerabilities and operational risks; and develop policies related to incident and problem management, asset and configuration management, release and change management, service request and delivery management, and architectural and technology management; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated December 9, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21610; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21610.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


