## ORDINANCE NUMBER O- **21622** (NEW SERIES) DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR **17** 2023

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING AN ASSISTANT DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION IN THE PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Public Utilities Department (Department) to exempt an Assistant Deputy Director position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Deputy Director position will develop and oversee the Dam Safety Program. This position will support the Deputy Director over the Engineering and Program Management Division in directing and coordinating policies and facilitating the work of the division; plan, organize, manage, and evaluate the Dam Safety Program and staff efforts related to the City's nine dams; conduct dam condition assessments and plan dam repair; develop policies related to dam design, engineering standards, and communication protocols; represent the Department before a variety of governing bodies within the City; and participate in negotiations with a variety of state dam safety and water agencies; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Assistant Deputy Director position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated November 4, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- **21622**; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.
