DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 17 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO
THE AGREEMENT WITH PARSONS-BLACK & VEATCH
JOINT VENTURE FOR AS-NEEDED CONSTRUCTION
MANAGER-TREATMENT PLANT AND FACILITIES
PROJECTS (CONTRACT NO. H176935) AND RELATED
ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, in July 2018, the City awarded an agreement to Parsons-Black & Veatch
Joint Venture to perform as-needed construction management services for the Pure Water
Treatment Plant and Facilities for a period of five years, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000,000,
which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-311674 (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2021 the City executed the first amendment to the Agreement
adding Project Labor Agreement requirements and new City insurance requirements; and

WHEREAS, the second amendment will extend the term of the Agreement for an
additional three years, increase the not to exceed amount of the Agreement by \$35,000,000 for a
total not to exceed amount of \$110,000,000, and additional scope of work as more fully set forth
in the proposed second amendment which is included in the staff materials accompanying this
ordinance (Second Amendment); and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the
information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true,
and accurate;

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for
a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-
thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Second Amendment extending the term of the Agreement for an additional three years, increasing the not to exceed amount of the Agreement to \$110,000,000 and adding additional services to be performed for the remainder of the term, which once signed by all parties and approved as to form, will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21623, is approved.


Section 2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to sign and deliver the Second Amendment.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an additional amount not to exceed \$35,000,000 from Fund 700011, Water Utility Operating Fund, Fund 700010, Water Utility CIP, Fund 700001, Metro Sewer Utility, and Fund 70009, Metro Sewer CIP, for the purpose of executing this Second Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from
and after its final passage.


