

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21626 (NEW SERIES)DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 28 2023AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE COMPLIANCE DEPARTMENT FROM
THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2022, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Office of the Chief Operating Officer to exempt a Program Manager position in the Compliance Department from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will be placed in the Compliance Department to assist with the City's compliance initiatives. This position will improve and provide audit support to City departments in order to maintain compliance with federal grants; develop policies and ensure City compliance with federal grants and Title VI requirements; work with the Mayor's policy team and executive team to respond to Grand Jury reports; and respond to outside auditors on how federal funds are used and/or certify outside auditor review of City programs and policies; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager position, as described by the Office of the Chief Operating Officer, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated December 9, 2022 to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21626; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position in the Compliance Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21626

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.




