AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT PAST FIVE YEARS FOR AS-NEEDED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH PARSONS TRANSPORTATION GROUP, INC.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) entered into an as-needed professional services agreement with Parsons Transportation Group, Inc. (Consultant) on April 19, 2021 for civil engineering design services to support the City's Capital Improvement Projects (H207141) (Agreement). These services include, but are not limited to, preparation of construction drawings, contract documents, reports, and construction period services; and

WHEREAS, City issued Consultant 14 tasks under the Agreement and six of those tasks are still in design, and construction is not expected to be completed until 2026; and

WHEREAS, to complete the remaining six tasks, the Agreement will need to be amended to extend the term of the contract to 72 months; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement with Consultant to extend the contract duration from 24 months to 72 months, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21629.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
