DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 23 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTANT POSITION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Department of Finance (Department) to exempt a Principal Accountant position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Principal Accountant position will oversee the budget processes and reports for capital budget development, Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) monitoring, supplemental CIP budget adjustments, and operating Department submissions. This position will oversee the Stormwater Department's CIP activity and the Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department's capital needs; represent the Department at Capital Budget Executive Review Committee meetings; implement Council Policy 800-14 (CIP Prioritization); and develop Department-wide capital budget policies and ensure projects comply with policies; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Principal Accountant position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated April 10, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21644.; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Service the Principal Accountant position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21644

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
