

## ORDINANCE NUMBER O- **21656** (NEW SERIES)

## 

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION IN THE SPECIAL EVENTS AND FILMING DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Special Events and Filming Department (Department) to exempt a Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will be responsible for overseeing the special event permit application process for the Parks and Recreation Department, specific to special event permits for commercial vending on City parkland and the utilization of parkland and public right-of-way. This position will work with the Planning Department and the Office of the City Attorney to evaluate the requirements of Notice of Right to Appeal (NORA) and develop a Memorandum of Understanding to govern future park use permit NORA procedures; recommend improvements to current processes and policies related to special events; develop policies that guide commercial activities on parklands that require special event permits and develop new special event permits for park use; and develop an outreach plan to target organizers based on tactical equity goals; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

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WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated April 10, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-<u>**21656**</u>; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Program Coordinator position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-\_\_\_\_21656\_\_\_\_

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

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Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
