DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 26 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING POST-EMPLOYMENT HEALTH BENEFITS FOR ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES WHO WERE HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2005, AND RETIRE AFTER MARCH 31, 2012, STRIKING ARTICLE 9 AND EXTENDING THE TERM BY 15 YEARS.

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2012, the San Diego City Council (Council) adopted Ordinance O-20135, which approved and ratified the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of San Diego (City) and the San Diego Police Officers Association (POA) for the term of April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2027, regarding Post-Employment Health Benefits for eligible employees who were hired before July 1, 2005, and retire after March 31, 2012 (MOU); and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2012, Council adopted Ordinance O-20173, which amended the MOU to provide that mandatory employee contributions to the Post-Employment Health Benefits Plan would be made on a post-tax basis to comply with applicable federal tax laws; and

WHEREAS, Article 5 of the of the MOU requires a six (6) vote approval of Council to reopen the meet and confer process, if either the City or POA desires to modify the MOU on or after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Article 5 of the MOU, on February 1, 2023, Council approved Resolution R-314587, which authorized reopening of the meet and confer process to modify the MOU by striking the "Me-Too" Clause set forth in Article 9; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to approve the reopening of the meet and confer process to modify the MOU by striking the "Me-Too" Clause set forth in Article 9; and

WHEREAS, the City has met and conferred with POA and reached agreement to strike the "Me-Too" Clause set forth in Article 9 and to extend the term of the MOU for an additional 15 years; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to approve the agreement with POA to modify the MOU by striking the "Me-Too" Clause set forth in Article 9 and extending the term so the MOU for an additional 15 years; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance must be approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the Council, in accordance with San Diego Charter section 11.2; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to the Meyers-Miliias-Brown Act and City Council Policy 300-06, the City Council approves the amending of the MOU by striking the "Me-Too" Clause set forth in Article 9 and extension of the term of the MOU for an additional 15 years.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage, in accordance with Charter section 99.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from  
and after its final passage.
