AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Police Department (Department) to exempt two Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the first Program Coordinator position will oversee the Data Analysis

Section of the Information Services Division. This position will implement emerging technology
and data to help fight crime and address demographic, equity, and homelessness issues; develop
reports and provide recommendations regarding crime statistics and crime data to the Police
Chief, City Council, Mayor's Office, and external agencies; and develop policies and procedures
related to data collection, crime analysis methodologies, and evolving technologies used to
gather and disseminate data; and

WHEREAS, the second Program Coordinator position will oversee the Investigative Support Section of the Information Services Division. This position will oversee technical and scientific investigative services; serve as the administrator for the Department's collection of law enforcement portals and tools; support Geographical Information Science services by providing reports, maps, and geo-spatial data to the Police Chief, City Council, Mayor's Office, and external agencies regarding crime statistics and trends, and to solve crimes; and develop policies and procedures related to data collection, crime analysis methodologies, and evolving technologies used to gather and disseminate data; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated April 10, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO
21680; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Service the two Program Coordinator positions in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-____21680_.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage. APPROVED: MARA W.
