DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 14 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING AN ASSISTANT DEPUTY
DIRECTOR AND A PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION
IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Department of Information Technology (Department) to exempt an Assistant Deputy Director and a Program Coordinator position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Deputy Director position will oversee the architecture, design, analysis, administration, and engineering of the enterprise information technology environment; develop policies, programs, and procedures related to the enterprise; manage third party vendors to ensure systems are well architected and designed; provide technical outreach and direction for operations; and implement and coordinate policies, procedures, and standards; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator position will manage the City's digital equity initiative, SD Access 4 All; develop the SD Access 4 All digital equity program and services to increase community technology access outcomes; manage the coordination of public and private, interagency, and interdepartmental partnerships and support associated Climate Action Plan actions; manage procurement for the program's equipment and materials; oversee competitive technology access project grants; and develop policies on the delivery of Citywide infrastructure and digital equity; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or

administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 2, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21685 ; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Assistant Deputy Director and the Program Coordinator position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21685 .

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


