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AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM MANAGER AND FOUR PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITIONS IN THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Human Resources Department (Department) to exempt two Program Manager and four Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, one Program Manager position will oversee the Recruiting and Retention Section; identify critical position gaps and design a recruitment strategy that includes preparing, sourcing, screening, selecting, hiring, and onboarding Unclassified employees; oversee the City's Compensation Philosophy, monitor compensation trends, and provide guidance to the City's Executive Team regarding Unclassified compensation adjustments; and develop human resource policies, initiatives, and programs related to the recruiting and retention of Unclassified employees; and

WHEREAS, one Program Manager position will serve as a Senior Human Resources

Officer (HRO); serve as liaison to all City departments by providing guidance and policy advice
on labor employment issues and regulations, the meet and confer process, grievance resolution,
disciplinary actions and appeals, leave provisions, federal and state employment and labor laws,
and rewards and recognition programs; participate in labor negotiations and analyze proposals
before meeting and conferring with the impacted employee organizations; and develop human
resource policies affecting labor and employee relations; and

WHEREAS, two Program Coordinator positions will support the Recruiting and Retention Program; liaison with City departments to identify critical position gaps; implement recruitment strategies; implement the City's Compensation Philosophy; monitor compensation trends; provide guidance to City departments regarding Unclassified compensation adjustments; and develop human resource policies, initiatives, and programs related to the recruitment and retention of Unclassified employees; and

WHEREAS, two Program Coordinator positions will serve as Human Resources

Coordinators. One position will be assigned to perform employee relations duties such as liaising with City departments to provide guidance and policy advice on various employment issues such as City policies and regulations, grievance resolution, federal and state labor laws, and rewards and recognition programs; implement employment related trainings and provide ongoing mentoring; represent the City on various City committees; and develop human resource policies affecting employee relations. The second position will be assigned to perform labor relations duties such as assisting City liaisons with the City's Recognized Employee Organizations; assist in meet and confer processes; make presentations to the Mayor, City Council, and management; facilitate Labor Management Committee meetings; provide guidance, policy advice, and trainings; and develop human resource policies, initiatives, and programs related to labor relations; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority

and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 2, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO
21691; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the two Program Manager and four Program Coordinator positions in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
