AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A DEPUTY DIRECTOR AND A PROGRAM MANAGER POSITION IN THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Parks and Recreation Department (Department) to exempt a Deputy Director and a Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director position will be responsible for overseeing the new Citywide Park Maintenance Division (Division); managing park maintenance for the Department; overseeing the operations of maintenance at all park facilities, centers, and areas; developing policies and procedures related to Citywide park maintenance; developing the Division 's budget; and implementing, monitoring, and evaluating operations in coastal, open space, developed regional parks, facilities, and recreation sites; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will manage the Get It Done (GID) platform; oversee the GID platform which includes quality assurance, service delivery, report generation, trend analysis, and customer support; develop and implement policies and procedures related to improving operational efficiencies for GID tracking and finding ways to maximize the platform; evaluate effectiveness and processing times; identify trends by analyzing data from GID; document, analyze, and implement system changes and requirements; develop training on the GID platform; and integrate internal controls, policies, and procedures; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or

administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the positions, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found they meet the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 2, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21692; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Service the Deputy Director and the Program Manager position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21692

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.
