

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21695 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 14 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING AN ASSISTANT POLICE CHIEF
POSITION IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE
CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2023, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego (City) reviewed a request from the Police Department (Department) to exempt an Assistant Police Chief position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Police Chief position will oversee the Office of Constitutional Policing and Strategic Planning; implement and oversee compliance and reporting on federal, state, and local legislative mandates; develop policies and procedures related to constitutional policing and public safety; oversee the Force Analysis Unit that researches trends impacting public safety and the use of force; liaison with the Office of the City Auditor and the Office of the Independent Budget Analyst to identify strategic planning goals; liaison with the Commission on Police Practices and Citizens Advisory Board on Police Practices on procedural and policy recommendations; and develop a biannual strategic plan for the Department; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated June 2, 2023, to the Honorable Council President and members of the City Council (Council), prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21695; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Assistant Police Chief position in the Department whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-21695.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
