AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT H166752 WITH KENNEDY/JENKS CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE ALVARADO 2ND PIPELINE EXTENSION PROJECT AND RELATED ACTIONS.

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WHEREAS, the Alvarado 2nd Pipeline Extension Project (Project) will provide redundancy in the water system and provide for the efficient delivery of water treated at the Alvarado Water Treatment Plant to the coastal communities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Request for Proposal, Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc.

(Consultant) was selected to provide professional engineering services for the design,

construction support, and post-construction support and related work for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2017, the San Diego City Council (Council) passed Ordinance No. O-20875 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to execute phase-funded consultant agreement H166752 with Consultant to provide professional engineering services for the design, construction support, and post-construction support and related work for the Project (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, as a result of delays, the anticipated construction duration for the Project has been extended beyond the original Agreement term; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Agreement is now necessary in order to cover the additional time and associated costs (First Amendment); and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement, or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a twothirds majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement with Kennedy/Jenks Consultants, Inc. for additional services, construction support, and as-built record drawing services in CIP S-12013, Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline. The First Amendment will add an additional \$3,981,529 to the Agreement for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$9,376,110. The First Amendment will also extend the consultant agreement by an additional 72 months to January 11, 2030. The First Amendment is included in the staff materials accompanying this ordinance, and once signed, will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00 - 21.713

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend funds for Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment, under the established contract funding phases in the amount not to exceed \$9,376,110.00; of which \$748,612.00 is for Phase III, and \$3,232,917.00 is for all subsequent phases in CIP S-12013, Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline, Fund 700010, Water Utility CIP, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure under the established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
