AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE LAW FIRM OF HUGO PARKER LLP FOR CONTINUED LEGAL SERVICES RELATING TO ALINA CADENA, ET AL. V. CITY OF SAN DIEGO ET AL.

WHEREAS, Hugo Parker, LLP (Hugo Parker) currently serves as the City's outside litigation counsel in the case entitled *Alina Cadena, et al v. City of San Diego*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2019-00032076-CU-MC-CT. Plaintiffs are current and former City of San Diego employees who allege asbestos exposure while working in commercial property commonly known as the Executive Complex located at 1010 Second Avenue, San Diego, California, 92101, commonly known as Executive Complex; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2019, the Purchasing Agent approved the Request and Certification for Sole Source Procurement; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, the City Council passed Resolution Number R-312673 authorizing the retention of Hugo Parker and approving the agreement for legal services (Legal Services Agreement) with Hugo Parker not to exceed \$300,000 on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-312673; and

WHEREAS, additional funding in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 is now needed to ensure adequate funding for the legal services provided by Hugo Parker, LLP (Law Firm) to complete the Scope of Services in the Legal Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Law Firm will soon exceed the Legal Services Agreement term of four

years, presently set to end on October 18, 2023; and

WHEREAS, under the Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation for a

period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds

majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the First Amendment to the Legal Services Agreement with Law Firm is

approved, and the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the

legal services agreement with the Law Firm, to increase the term of the contract by two years, for

a total not to exceed six years.

Section 2. That the expenditure of an additional amount not to exceed \$200,000 is

authorized for the purpose of executing the Amendment, contingent upon the City Comptroller

first certifying funds are available providing funds for the above referenced Amendment.
