## DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 2 2 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH AON RISK INSURANCE SERVICES WEST, INC. FOR THE OWNER CONTROLLED INSURANCE PROGRAM (RFP NO. 10089372-18-V) AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, in January 2019 the City awarded an agreement to AON Risk Insurance Services West, Inc. to act as the City's Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) broker of record for the Pure Water Phase 1 Program for a period of five years, in an amount not to exceed \$999,750 (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Associated General Contractors of America, San Diego Chapter, filed a lawsuit against the City of San Diego, delaying the implementation of the Pure Water Phase 1 Program by approximately 18 months; and

WHEREAS, construction related activities for the Pure Water Phase 1 Program are anticipated to last approximately five (5) more years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3208(d), award of a sole source contract is appropriate as a competitive process would be undesirable for the continued, uninterrupted, and effective administration of the OCIP insurance coverage for the Pure Water Phase 1 Program; and

WHEREAS, the first amendment will extend the term of the Agreement for an additional five years to allow for the continued administration of the OCIP insurance coverage for the Pure Water Phase 1 Program, increase the not to exceed amount of the Agreement by \$886,772.04 for a total not to exceed amount of \$1,886,522.04, and amend the scope of work as more fully set

forth in the proposed first amendment which is included in the staff materials accompanying this ordinance (First Amendment); and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a twothirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the First Amendment, which extends the term of the Agreement for an additional five years, increases the total not to exceed amount of the Agreement to \$1,886,522.04, and amends the scope of work, which once signed by all parties and approved as to form, will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-

**21748**, is approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to sign and deliver the First Amendment.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an additional amount not to exceed \$886,772.04 from Fund 700001, Metro Sewer Utility Fund and Fund 700011, Water Utility Operating Fund, for the purpose of executing this First Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer. Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a

written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
