A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO RATIFY AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH SERVICE AMERICA CORPORATION (DBA CENTERPLATE) FOR FOOD SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO TEMPORARILY RESIDED AT THE SAN DIEGO CONVENTION CENTER'S EMERGENCY HOMELESS SHELTER IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) Purchasing & Contracting Department is requesting ratification of the agreement between the City and Service America Corporation (dba Centerplate) (Agreement) to provide food services for individuals who temporarily resided at the San Diego Convention Center's Emergency Homeless Shelter in response to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) section 22.3208(b) authorizes the award of emergency contracts without advertisement or a competitive process when it is necessary to safeguard life, health, or property due to extraordinary fire, flood, storm, epidemic, or other disaster, provided that the Purchasing Agent immediately reports the emergency award and its justifications to the City Council in writing and the City Council ratifies the award by resolution and by a two-thirds vote; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of California declared a state of emergency as a result of the threat of the coronavirus, COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the Mayor of the City of San Diego (Mayor) proclaimed the existence of a local emergency related to the COVID-19 threat, which was ratified by the San Diego City Council on March 17, 2020 by Resolution No. R-312895; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Governor of California issued Executive Order N-33-20 ordering everyone living in the State of California to stay home or at their place of residence, except to obtain essential services; and

WHEREAS, approximately a year before, on March 25, 2019, City Council declared a shelter crisis to facilitate opening and operation of several temporary bridge shelters (Resolution R-312284); and

WHEREAS, as part of the City's response to the COVID-19 emergency, on April 1, 2020, the City launched Operation Shelter to Home and moved individuals into the San Diego Convention Center to help comply with the County Public Health Order and to allow for proper physical distancing and prevent the spread of COVID-19 among San Diego's homeless population (Executive Order No. 2020-3); and

WHEREAS, after evaluating several food provider options, Service America Corporation (dba Centerplate), the San Diego Convention Center's food service and concessions provider, had the supplies and operational ability to accommodate, on short notice, the request to provide meals in individually boxed containers in order to minimize contact between individuals and prevent the spread of illness; and

WHEREAS, the City executed an agreement with Centerplate to provide food services to those housed in the Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, this contract with Centerplate was exempt from competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Municipal Code section 22.3208(b) because it is a contract necessary to safeguard life and health due to the COVID-19 emergency, and the Purchasing Agent reported the emergency award and its justifications to the City Council on September 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Operation Shelter to Home program was discussed with City Council at the April 7, 2020, June 16, 2020, October 13, 2020, and January 26, 2021 Council meetings; and

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WHEREAS, by March 31, 2021, Operation Shelter to Home program ended at the

Convention Center having safely served over 400,000 individually boxed meals to nearly 4,200

individuals expending a total amount of \$9,776,628.53; and

WHEREAS, the additional funds for this contract were fully expended in fiscal year 2021

from sources including Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) fund, State of

California COVID-19 Homeless Emergency Grants, Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP)

grant, and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, and there are no future costs

associated with this contract; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3208 (b) requires that City Council

ratify this emergency contract by resolution and by a two-thirds vote; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the

information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true,

and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Agreement

between the City and Service America Corporation (dba Centerplate) for food services in

response to the COVID-19 emergency, that is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document

No. RR 314563, is ratified and approved.
