A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING MID-YEAR REVISIONS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2022, the Mayor approved Resolution No. R-314153, approving the City's Fiscal Year 2023 Budget (2023 Budget); and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-21476,

entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 and Appropriating the

Necessary Money to Operate the City of San Diego for Fiscal Year 2023" (Appropriation

Ordinance); and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, the Department of Finance presented to the City

Council its Fiscal Year 2023 First Quarter Budget Monitoring Report (First Quarter Report); and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2023, the Department of Finance issued its Fiscal Year 2023

Mid-Year Budget Monitoring Report (Mid-Year Report); and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Year Report projects additional resources of \$33.2 million relative to the 2023 Budget as implemented by the Appropriation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Appropriations Ordinance authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to modify appropriations upon adopted Council resolution, provided funding is available for such action and in accordance with funding source guidelines and applicable grant agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the proposed appropriation changes as described below and in accordance with the Mid-Year Report; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to revise the 2023 Budget, as detailed in the Mid-Year Report, as follows:
