A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$8,500 TO RISE URBAN LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE RISE URBAN FELLOWS LEADERSHIP PROGRAM PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the RISE Urban Leadership Institute of San Diego has requested funding for the RISE Urban Fellows Leadership Program; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used for facility rent, classroom supplies, faculty stipends, and costs associated with technical training; and

WHEREAS, RISE Urban Leadership Institute of San Diego's request for funding for the RISE Urban Fellows Leadership Program will benefit the public by helping urban community leaders become authentic and empathetic leaders who are suited to provide community solutions; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 2, 4, and 5 recommend a total allocation of \$8,500 to the RISE Urban Leadership Institute of San Diego for the purposes set forth in this resolution, attributed as follows: Council District 2 – \$2,000; Council District 4 – \$5,000; and Council District 5 –\$1,500; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego (City), a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City and the RISE Urban Leadership Institute of San Diego (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$8,500 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314620 .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,000 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center No. 1102110002;

\$5,000 from Council District 4: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center No. 1104110004; and \$1,500 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center No. 1105110005, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
