A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR THE SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT GRANT FOR THE SAN PASQUAL VALLEY GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN. IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, in 2014, the California Legislature and Governor passed into law the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA), which provides a framework to manage and protect groundwater resources in California; and

WHEREAS, SGMA applies to all California groundwater basins and requires that highand medium-priority groundwater basins form Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) and be managed in accordance with locally developed Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSPs); and

WHEREAS, basin prioritization is determined by the Department of Water Resources (DWR), which classified the San Pasqual Valley (SPV) Groundwater Basin (Basin) as a medium-priority basin; and

WHEREAS, as required by SGMA, the City and the County of San Diego (County) formed a GSA and developed the SPV GSP to manage groundwater resources in the SPV Basin; and

WHEREAS, the SGM Grant Program's SGMA Implementation Round 2 will provide funding to GSAs to update/revise/modify their GSPs for construction projects and management actions required by the State for the implementation of the GSP that is for eligible applicants with projects located in medium and high priority basins; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department intends to apply for this grant as the GSA representative to offset the required costs of supporting the State-mandated SPV GSP implementation and compliance activities, including: preparation of annual reports and the 5-year plan update, numerical modeling, monitoring, public outreach, data management system updates, and feasibility studies; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to take all necessary actions to apply to the California Department of Water Resources and to secure grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$2,771,000 for the SGM Implementation, Round 2 grant.
- 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,771,000 if grant funding is secured.
- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interestbearing account for the grant, if required.
