DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 17 2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO C&C MENTOR PROTEGE, DIAMOND BUSINESS ASSOCIATION, INC., DREAMS & DUCATS, ELEMENTARY INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE, AND THE BLUE HEART FOUNDATION, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego received and evaluated five applications for Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

Dreams & Ducats	Journey to Impact	Strengthens community bonds and engagement.
Elementary Institute of Science	STEM Field Trips for Lincoln Cluster Students	Provides STEM-based educational programs to students.

The Blue Heart Foundation	Signing Day	Provides academic assistance and career development opportunities.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to C&C Mentor Protégé for the Mentor Protégé Program, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$10,000 to Diamond Business Association, Inc. for the Diamond BID Bridge Lighting, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Dreams & Ducats for Journey to Impact, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Elementary Institute of Science for STEM Field Trips for Lincoln Cluster Students, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 4 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to The Blue Heart Foundation for Signing Day, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for C&C Mentor Protégé and the Diamond Business Association, Inc., the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that for C&C Mentor Protégé and Dreams & Ducats, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) C&C Mentor Protégé in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (2) Diamond Business Association, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$10,000, (3) Dreams & Ducats in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (4) Elementary Institute of Science in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, and (5) The Blue Heart Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$30,000 from Council District 4: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1104110004, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


