DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE **APR 14 2023**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 4 TO CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT K-19-1982-DBB-3 WITH CASS CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,206,009.49 WITHIN THE OTAY 2ND PIPELINE PHASE 1 PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER STATE CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15304(F).

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to execute Change Order No. 4 to the construction contract K-19-1982-DBB-3 (Contract) with Cass Construction, Inc. (Contractor) for construction of the Otay 2nd Pipeline Phase 1 project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21189.70.10, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., title 14, §§ 15000 to 15387 (CEQA Guidelines)) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15304(f); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record and related public comment with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that the Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15304(f) because it involves minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored; and

WHEREAS, the Council, exercising its independent judgment, determined that no exception set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 applies to the Project because no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; none of the land is adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources will be affected by the action; and none of the land is identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to California Government Code section 65962.5; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15304(f).

2. That no exception to the categorical exemption, set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project.
