A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSE ASSOCIATION AND WALKSANDIEGO DBA CIRCULATE SAN DIEGO, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy

100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on

June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and

uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with

non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental,

cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) received and evaluated two applications for

Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

ORGANIZATION	PROGRAM/ACTIVITY	PUBLIC BENEFIT
The Neighborhood House Association	NHA Senior Service Center	Decreasing the social isolation experienced by San Diego seniors.
WALKSANDIEGO dba Circulate San Diego	Transit for Fun	Educating the public and encouraging the use of public transportation.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$1,500 to The

Neighborhood House Association for social and recreational activity programs, class hosting, and personal protective equipment and supplies, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to WALKSANDIEGO dba Circulate San Diego for staff and personnel expenses, marketing, and transit expenses, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for WALKSANDIEGO dba Circulate San Diego, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) The Neighborhood House Association in an amount not to exceed \$1,500, (2) WALKSANDIEGO dba Circulate San Diego in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-**314746**<sup>-/</sup>

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for The Neighborhood House Association, and Document No. RR314746 for WALKSANDIEGO dba Circulate San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$6,500 from Council District 3: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1103110003, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
