

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 314809DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 08 2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO ARTREACH, BUSINESS FOR GOOD SAN DIEGO, DIVERSIONARY THEATRE PRODUCTIONS, INC, AND EL CAJON BOULEVARD BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) received and evaluated four applications for Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

Diversiónary Theatre Productions, Inc.	Diversiónary Theatre's The Stonewall Salon	Offering quality arts engagement for LGBTQ+ and allied citizens across San Diego.

El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association	D3 Blvd Crawl- Mardi Gras	Promoting the vibrancy and values of the Mid City area, and by bringing together businesses and residents.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$2,000 to ArtReach for teacher stipends, personnel costs, and art materials, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$4,000 to Business for Good San Diego for independent contractor costs, purchasing T-shirts, and purchasing banners., as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$3,000 to Diversionary Theatre Productions, Inc., for personnel and staffing expenses, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$6,200 to El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association for street safety equipment, promotional materials, lighting, printed media, sound, decorations, office supplies, banners, and other materials for the event, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for Business for Good San Diego, Diversionary Theatre Productions, Inc., and El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for ArtReach and Diversionary Theatre Productions, Inc., the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) ArtReach in an amount not to exceed \$2,000, (2) Business for Good San Diego in an amount not to exceed \$4,000, (3) Diversionary Theatre Productions, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$3,000, and (4) El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association in an amount not to exceed \$6,200, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314809.1 for ArtReach, Document No.

RR- 314809.2 for Business for Good San Diego, Document

No. RR- 314809.3 for Diversionary Theatre Productions, Inc., and Document


No. RR- 314809.4 for El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,200 from Council District 3: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1103110003, all to

provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
