A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A SIDE LETTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, AFL-CIO, LOCAL 127, TO AMEND ARTICLE 24 OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RELATED TO CITY HOLIDAYS.

WHEREAS, by San Diego Resolution R-313570 (June 11, 2021), the San Diego City Council (Council) approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of San Diego (City) and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 127 (Local 127) regarding terms and conditions of employment for employees represented by Local 127 for fiscal years 2022 and 2023; and

WHEREAS, Article 24 of the MOU lists the City's holidays, which are set forth under

San Diego Municipal Code section 21.0104; and

WHEREAS, by San Diego Ordinance O-21635 (April 24, 2023), the Council amended Municipal Code section 21.0104 to establish June 19, known as Juneteenth, as a City holiday; and redesignate the City holiday observed on the third Monday in February, which was known as Washington's Birthday, as Presidents' Day; and

WHEREAS, the City met and conferred with Local 127 and entered into a side letter agreement (Agreement) to amend Article 24 of the MOU to add Juneteenth to the list of City holidays and redesignate Washington's Day to Presidents' Day; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement must be approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the Council to take effect, in accordance with Charter section 11.2; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Agreement between the City and Local 127 to amend Article 24 of the MOU to add Juneteenth to the list of City holidays and redesignate Washington's Day to Presidents' Day, presented to the Council and on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-<u>31483</u>, approved, and takes effect upon the date of final passage of this Resolution.
