A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO CHICANO FEDERATION OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY, INC. (CHICANO FEDERATION OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY), LA JOLLA AQUATIC COMPLEX FOUNDATION, AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH COALITION, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) received and evaluated 3 applications for Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 1 recommends an allocation of \$2,500 to Chicano Federation of San Diego County for advertising, content creation, outreach content, and collateral, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 1 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to La Jolla Aquatic Complex Foundation for the purchase of parts implicated in the repair of lifeguard towers, including steps, a chair, a pedestal for the chair, a deck, umbrellas, wheels, and rubber covers on back tubing, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 1 recommends an allocation of \$3,000 to The Environmental Health Coalition for the purchase of LandVision Software, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for La Jolla Aquatic Complex Foundation and The Environmental Health Coalition, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for Chicano Federation of San Diego County, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) Chicano Federation of San Diego County in an amount not to exceed \$2,500, (2) La Jolla Aquatic Complex Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, and (3) The Environmental Health Coalition in an amount not to exceed \$3,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR- 314842-1 for Chicano Federation of San Diego County, Document No.

RR- 314842-2 for La Jolla Aquatic Complex Foundation, and Document No.

RR- 314842-3 for The Environmental Health Coalition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$10,500 from Council District 1: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1101110001, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
